# Humanities Trip to Amsterdam and Berlin Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2017 – Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017 (6 Days/5 Nights)

We are proposing a Humanities trip to Amsterdam, Holland and Berlin, Germany. This trip is primarily aimed at those opting to study History and/or RPE next year due to the strong links with the GCSE courses. However this trip will also enhance the Geography GCSE course through the studying of Tourism, Industry and Development. Finally, for any student opting to study German at GCSE level, this trip will give them the opportunity to practice their language skills.

We will be travelling by coach and ferry to Amsterdam where students stay overnight before visiting Anne Frank's house the following morning. We will then travel by coach to Berlin where we will stay a further 3 nights/4 days in Berlin before returning early morning on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April. Accommodation is on a half-board basis except on the days when we are travelling, therefore students will have to buy one breakfast and one dinner.

The total cost of the trip will be £575 which includes all travel, half-board accommodation (except where stated above), insurance and excursions. The only additional cost will be spending money for lunch, souvenirs, snacks and drinks. Excursions will include a visit to the Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp, the Olympic Stadium in Berlin, Hitler's WW2 bunker, the BMW plant, Berlin Zoo and the grounds of the SS and Gestapo Headquarters.

This trip is only open to students who have their own passport, which must be valid for the period of travel. Please contact me if your child does not hold an EU passport as I will need to make additional arrangements. You will also need to arrange for your child to have their own European Health Insurance Card. Applications can be made online at <a href="http://www.ehic.org.uk">http://www.ehic.org.uk</a> or by calling 0300 330 1350.

To secure a place, we need to have received an initial **non-refundable** deposit of £75.00 by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2016**. An interim **non-refundable** deposit of £150.00 will be due by **Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2016**. Subsequent payments can be made in instalments, but the full balance of £575 must be paid by **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2017**. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, although they are also conditional on students having a record of good behaviour. In the event that the trip is over-subscribed, priority will go to students who have opted to study GCSE History or RPE.

As we approach the trip, any cancellation will result in a loss of a percentage of the money, which increases as the time to departure gets closer. If you should choose to withdraw your child:

- 70 31 days before the trip, 50% of the money will be lost
- 30 days or less before the trip, all money will be lost
